OLD BUSINESS:

- While there was no July Monthly Meeting, one issue that occurred during July was a sewer line break on the Railroad property on Hill Street and Main. It was necessary to dig several feet near the railroad tracks/crossing to locate the manhole and repair the line making it necessary to involve the Railroad and raising the manhole to the surface rather than below grade by several feet. Discussion with the Board and our Solicitor is required on this topic due to the right of way issue with the Railroad.
- As we discussed at last month's meeting, PA American Water sent us the new rules and regulations
 regarding shutting off water to multi-family properties. Tenants in multi-family properties with owner
 overdue sewer accounts can now opt to pay the delinquent sewer bills of the property owners, deduct the
 amounts from their rent and NOT suffer any ramifications of eviction from the property owner. The
 specifics of these procedures were furnished to board members last month on your folders. We also

motioned to approve adopting these new procedures and had a motion to accept them by James Kroptavich and seconded by Willard Yates. Motion was accepted.

- DBSA also needs to continue discussion regarding the need for easements and/or notification to property owners when DBSA has a manhole on their property. There are several of these properties located on Foote Avenue due to a sewer line running behind the car wash on Foote Avenue. We have currently created a NOTICE to these residents who do not have easements on their properties in which DBSA will seek approval to come onto their properties by signing the NOTICE. Out Solicitor has indicated he will work on possible easements for properties, and whether or not there currently is an easement on the surrounding Nowikowski property.
- In continuation of our shut-offs of past due residential and multi-family properties, we currently have received approximately \$170,000 in past due payments. Second shut-off notices will be placed on 11 of the original single family properties and 6 of the 13 multi-family properties who have not either paid or made arrangements to pay their balances. Of these original past due accounts 8 owners have made and signed payment plans. Three of the multi-family properties have out of town owners and tenants will receive the PA American Water notices regarding possible payment/shut-off. At this time our time line for actual shut-offs by PA American Water is the week ending October 14th.

NEW BUSINESS:

- There were no new sewer permits issued during September of 2022. Please see the attached list in each board members folder.
- DBSA has spoken to Ken Salvo, Senior regarding driving and using our Jet Vac truck for repairs and maintenance to our sewer lines at the rate of \$25.00 per hour with Joe Pisanchyn as his helper as Joe has done in the past.
