OLD BUSINESS:

- DBSA needs to continue discussion regarding the need for easements and/or notification to property owners when DBSA has a manhole on their property. There are several of these properties located on Foote Avenue due to a sewer line running behind the car wash on Foote Avenue. We have currently created a NOTICE to these residents who do not have easements on their properties in which DBSA will seek approval to come onto their properties by signing the NOTICE. Out Solicitor has indicated he will work on possible easements for properties, and whether or not there currently is an easement on the surrounding Nowikowski property.
- DBSA would like to discuss implementing an Ordinance similar to the one created by PA Municipalities and Dallas Borough to require anyone purchasing a property within Duryea be required to have their lateral inspected prior to completion of their purchase. We are currently awaiting comment from Duryea Council regarding this matter.

- There was one new sewer permit #3057f 137 Cremard Blvd issued during December of 2022. Please see the attached list in each board members folder
- Bob Bejeski and Johnny Cremard will be raising the manhole on the Railroad property to grade as the
 Railroad buried this manhole (this was the manhole issue recently worked on by DBSA). The work was
 scheduled to be completed on December 19, 2022 but is on hold while issues with the Railroad requirements
 are being discussed.
- There is a sink hole at Hope and Grove Streets which needs to be dye tested to confirm there are no issues there. Also noted is the fact that the existing manhole has the old riser on it which DBSA does not approve of using and will require a back hoe to remove it for dye testing. This work is not yet scheduled to be completed.
- The Coxton Pump Station needs two new bolts for the floats which will be replaced by Bob Bejeski prior to winter.
- Happy Garden needs to be in compliance with a DBSA Ordinance regarding their grease trap. As there is no current Resolution or Ordinance, this issue requires discussion for resolutions on this matter.
